1. Vertical image-"Brown's Business College" painted on both sides of building on upper level. Other signage includes:

- Bills Floral Co.
- Martin Cigars
- Dr. J. B. Hayes, Dentist
- J. D. McCormick. Real Estate Insurance
- Shoes and Men's Shoes

This is the same building as seen on Pg.37 of Svendsen's *Davenport: A Pictorial History*.

William D. Petersen (son of John H. C. Petersen)

"The Straw Boss"-Pioneer member of Levee Improvement Commission
Standing in front of LeClaire Park seawall in about 1912. He is wearing a straw hat. This image used on pg.83 of Svendsen's *Davenport: A Pictorial History*.

"Bill" Hickey is handwritten at bottom of this image and on the back. Man with hair combed back, wearing wire rim glasses with relatively large lenses. Wearing dark suit with small stripe, white shirt, patterned tie.

Woman with dark hair, narrow dark ribbon "choker" with dangling pendant, is in two photographs with different poses. She is standing in the first, wearing a shiny dress of med-calf length with beading and sequins. Her dark stockings and dark shoes are a bit out of focus. She is holding a feathered item, possibly a handbag. No identification

In the second image the same woman is seated on a chair with her legs crossed. Her dark shoes and dark patterned stockings can be seen. She has a fur cape with large fur collar over the same dress. No identification
